Students at the TUM School of Medicine, here's a tip for you!

As part of the qualification program designed by TUM-GS and MGC/TUM School of Medicine you need to take part in a **good scientific practice seminar**:

- **Requirement for all doctoral candidates at the School of Medicine**, even members of thematic graduate centers, who registered as of January 1, 2017).
- **2-hour seminar** regularly offered by the MGC. You may also attend an equivalent event with comparable content (the MGC decides about the equivalence).
- You should attend **within the first 6 months** of the doctoral project.
